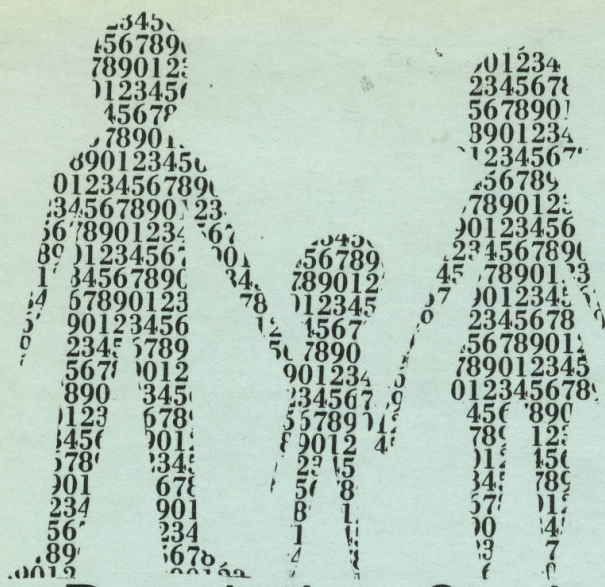

## INTRODUCTION

[ The purpose of this study is to provide information regarding historical population change and projected 1980 population in Franklin County. Information is available for internal and external use. ]

For this study, Franklin County was divided into five arbitrary geographic areas. These areas are indicated on the map on page 8. The boundaries of the five selected geographic areas follow the boundaries of townships of the county.

This study takes into account the declining birth rate, however the effect of the declining birth rate will be somewhat offset by the increased number of family formations in the next ten years since 183,822 (22 percent of the total population of Franklin County) are in the age group 10 to 20 years of age. This compares to 116,044 (17 percent of the total population) in the same age group in 1960. Also Franklin County will continue to increase in population due to in-migration.

[ Only Franklin County is included in this study. This county constitutes approximately 75 percent of the total electric sales of the Company. Population information relating to other counties in our service area is available and can be provided as required. ]

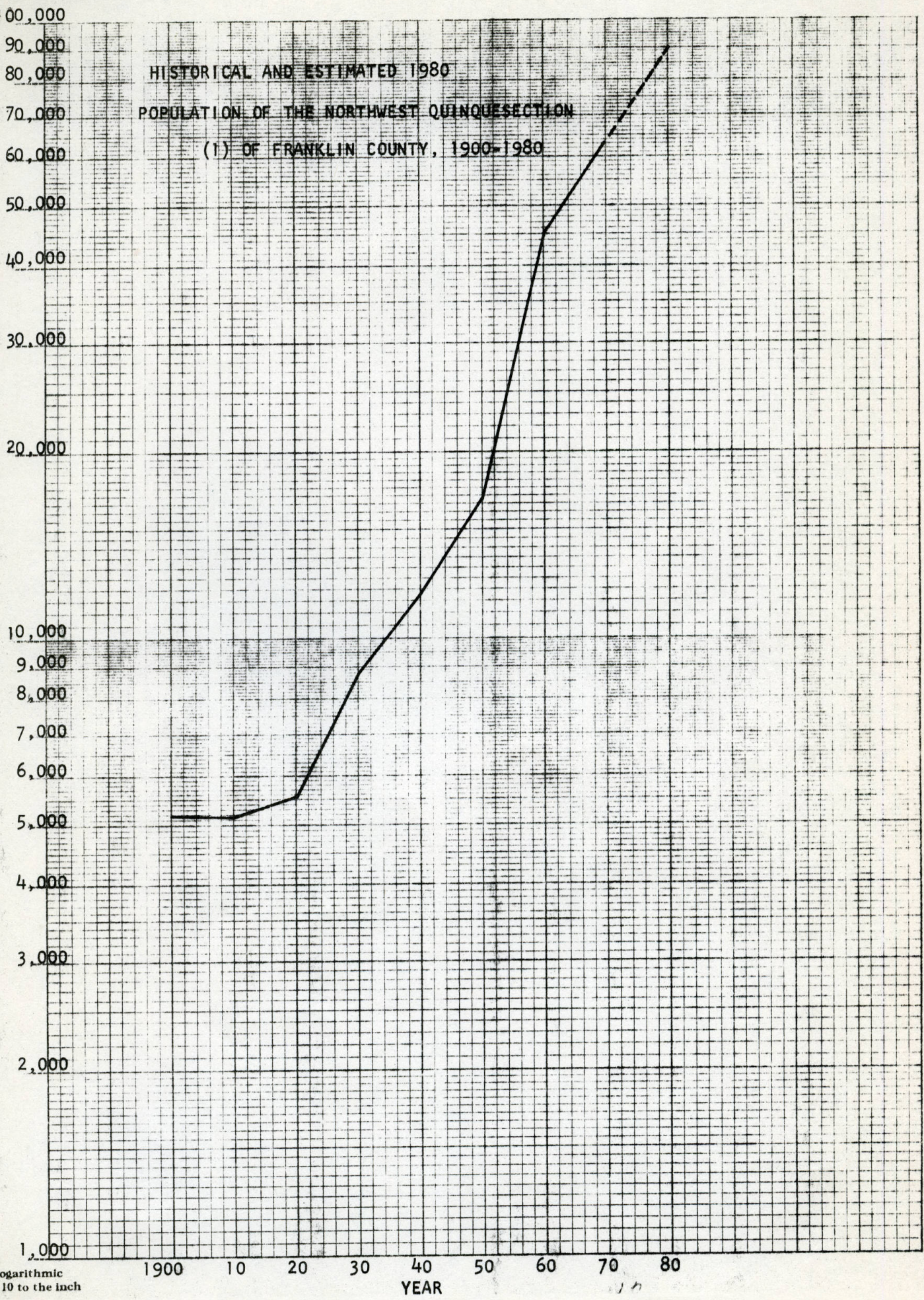

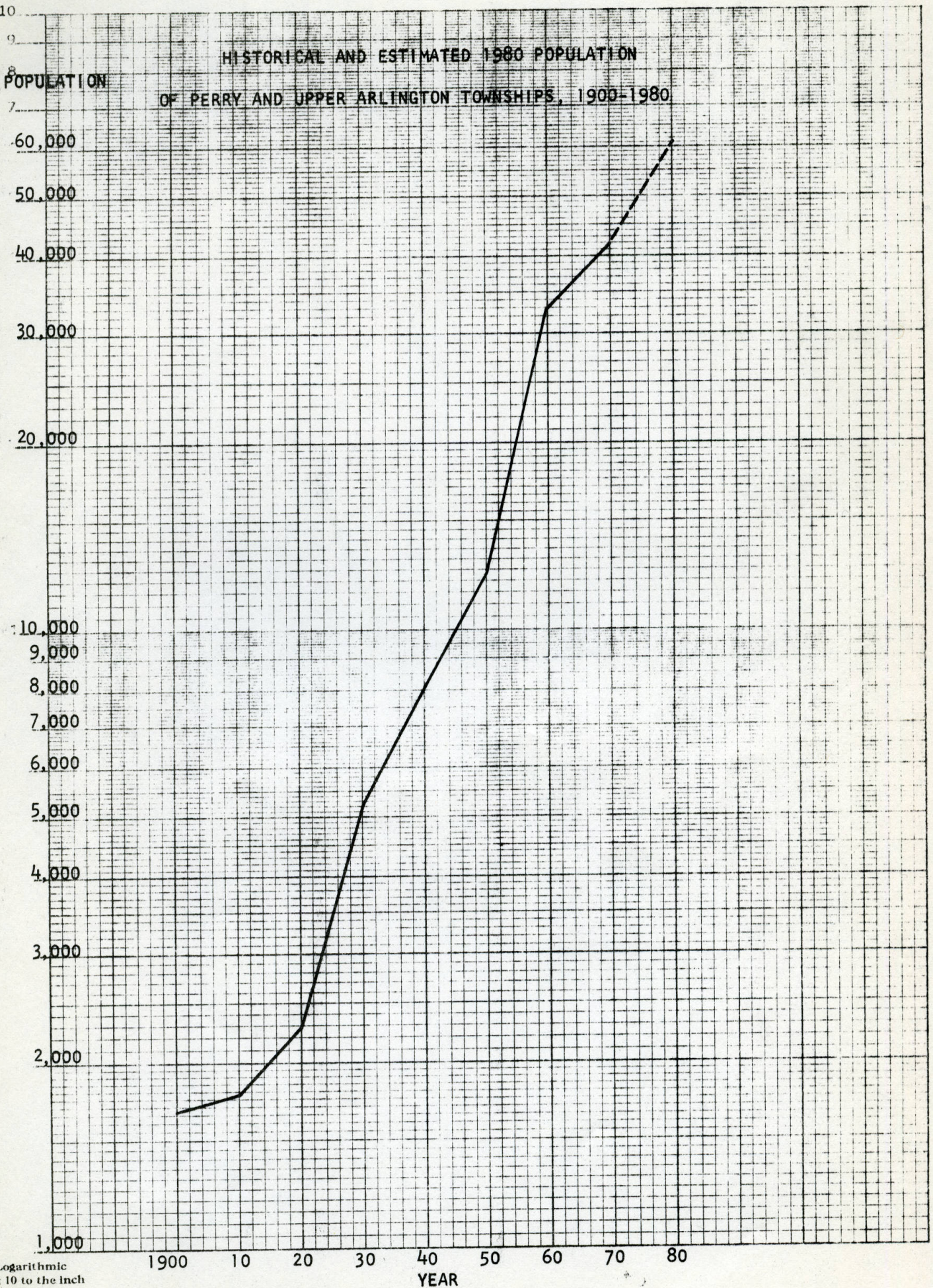

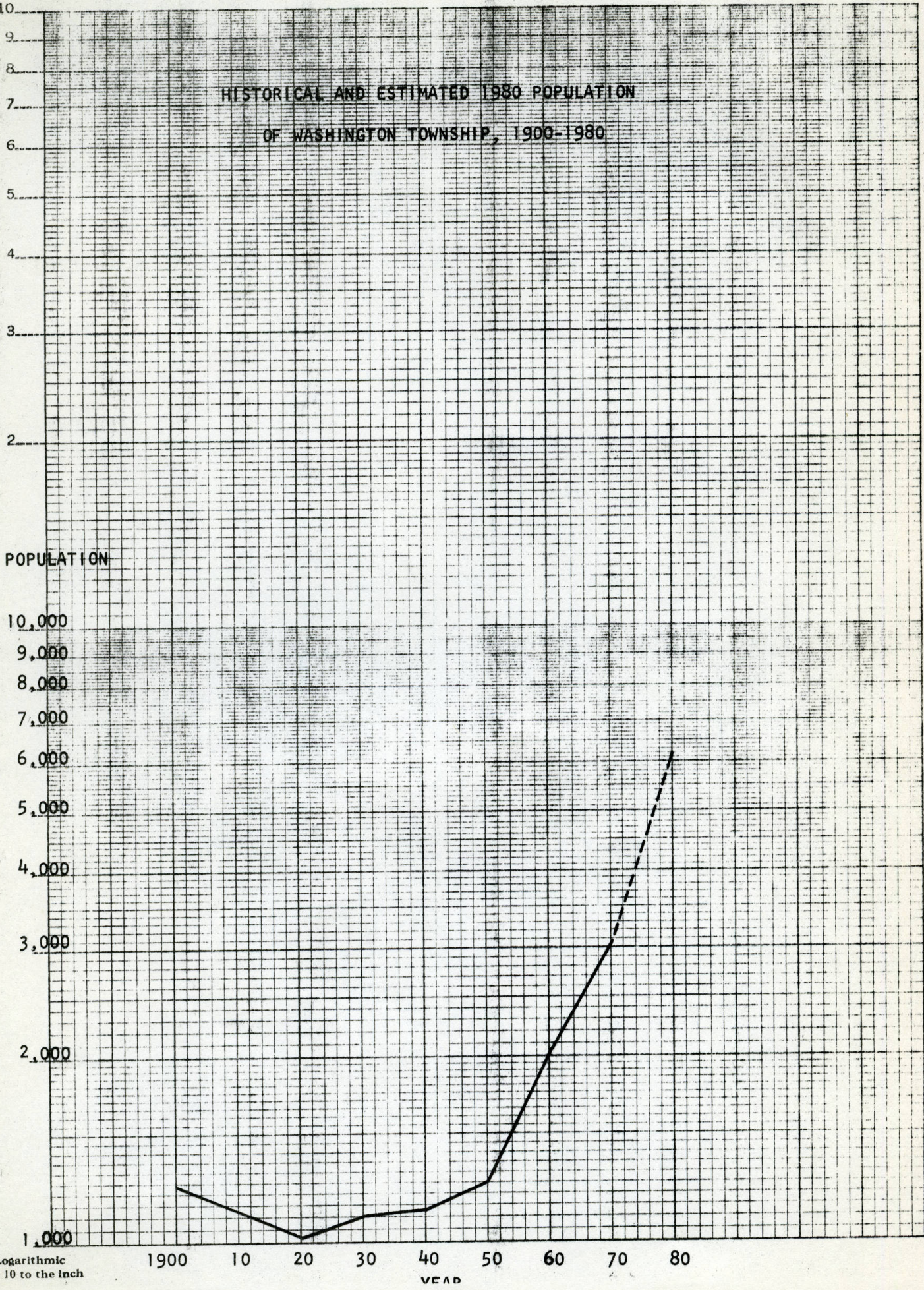

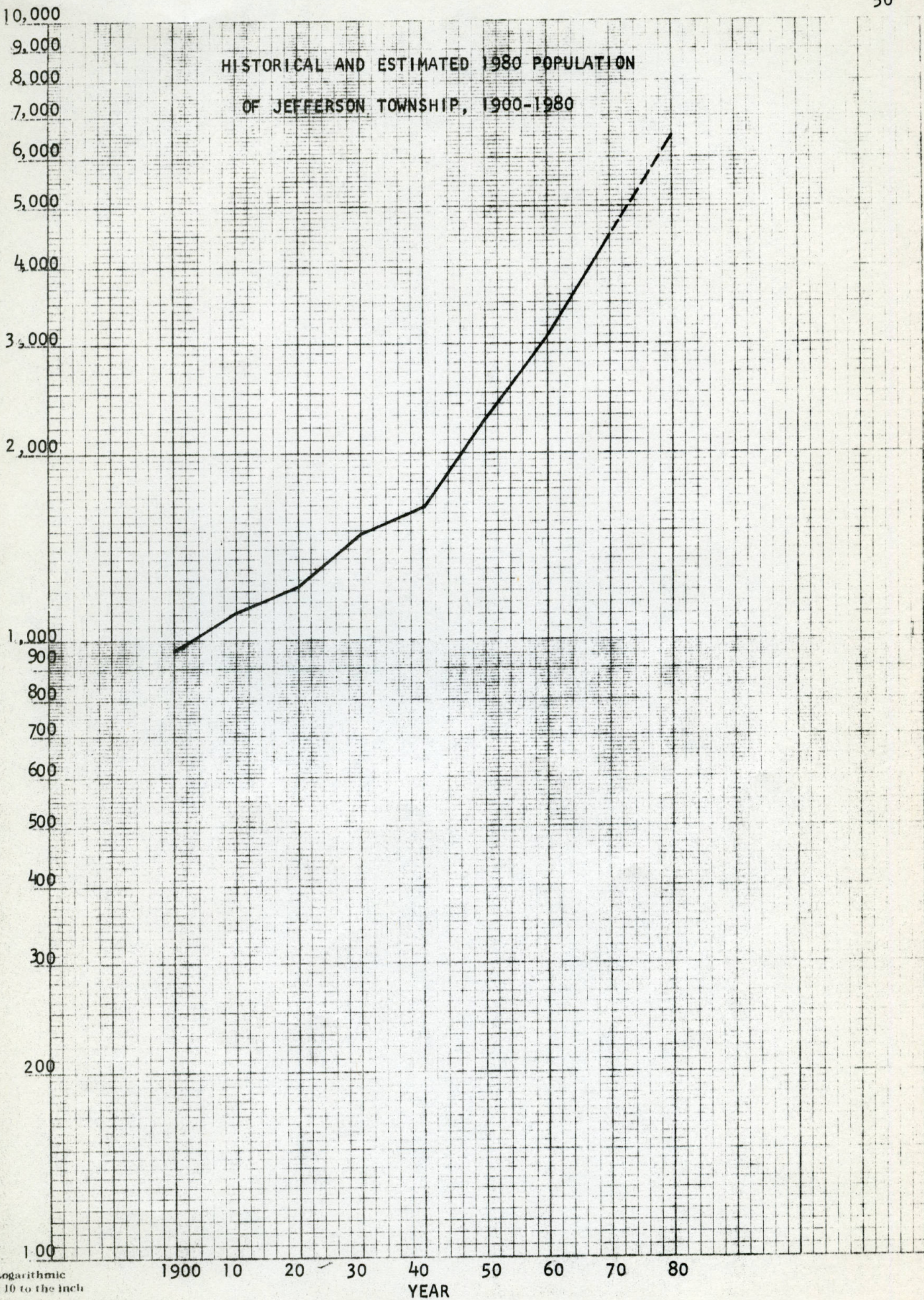

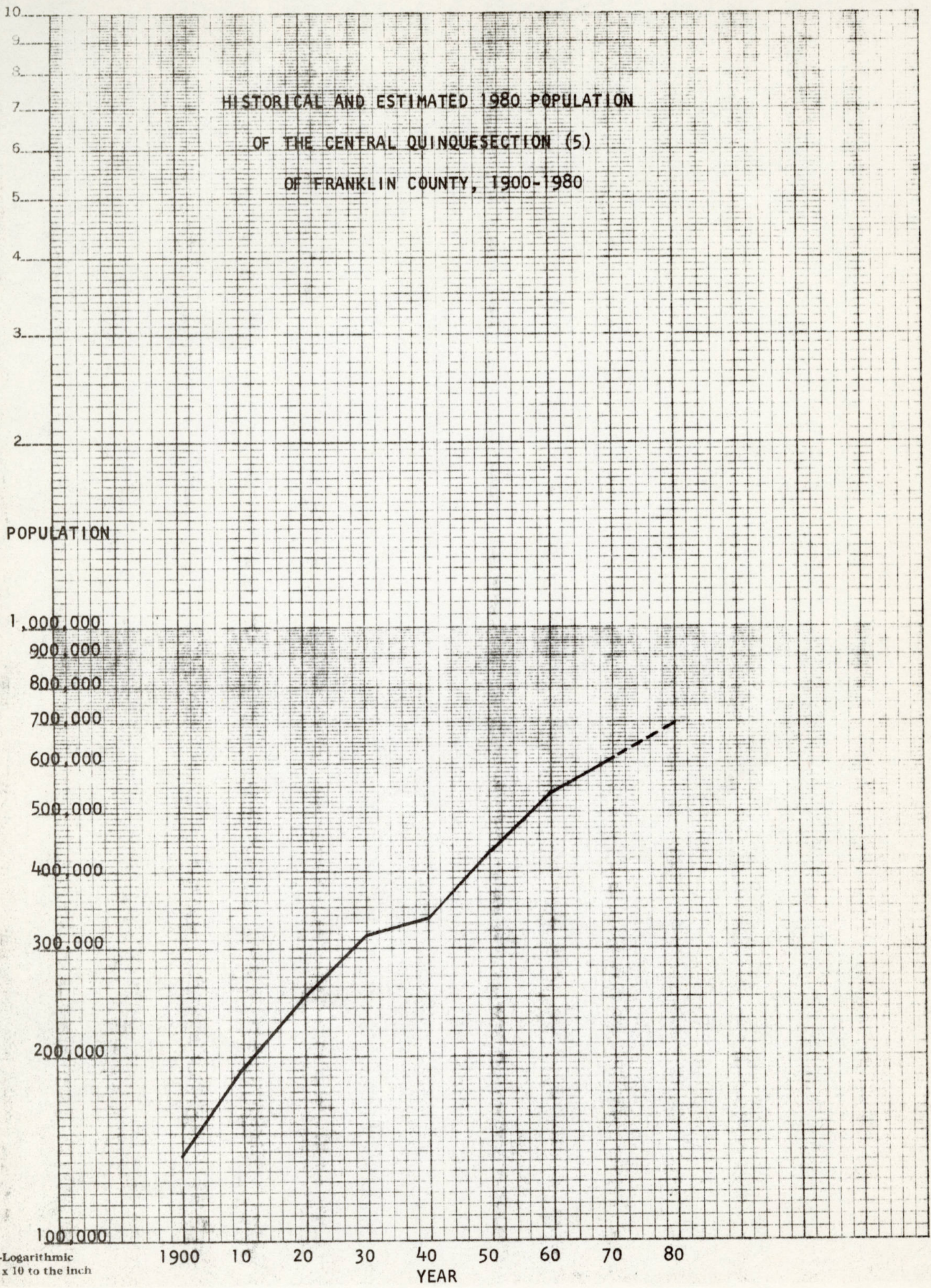

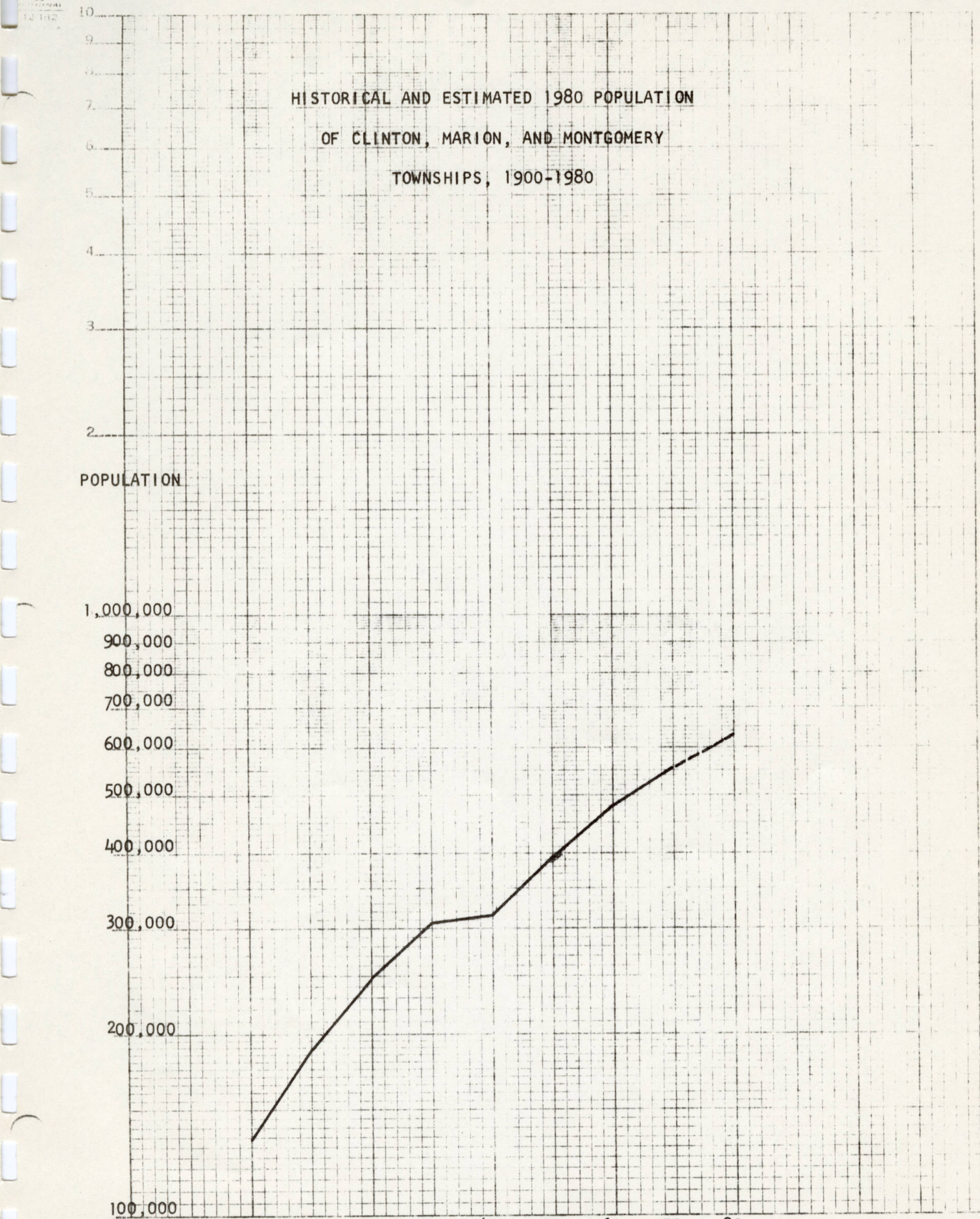
