THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE HAS ISSUED A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WATCH FOR A LARGE PART OF OHIO FROM 11 PM EST SATURDAY UNTIL 3AM EST SUNDAY. THE WATCH COVERS MOST OF CENTRAL OHIO.

A STRONG COLD FRONT MOVING THROUGH THE REGION HAS BEEN SETTING OFF SOME STRONG THUNDERSTORMS THROUGH INDIANA AND WESTERN OHIO. THE STORMS ARE MOVING NORTHEAST AROUND 45 MILES AN HOUR AND WILL REACH THE COLUMBUS AREA AROUND 11PM. AS THE THUNDERSTORMS MOVE PAST THERE WILL BE PERIODS OF HEAVY RAIN..STRONG GUSTY WINDS AND POSSIBLE HAIL.

THERE HAVE BEEN REPORTS OF WIND DAMAGE NEAR DAYTON AND TOLEDO EARLIER AS THE THUNDERSTORMS MOVED THROUGH THESE AREAS.

THUNDERSTORMS CONTAINING HEAVY RAIN WERE MOVING TOWARD CENTRAL OHIO THIS MORNING.

AT 825 AM WEATHER SERVICE RADAR SHOWED A LARGE AREA OF SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS OVER THE WESTERN HALF OF OHIO FROM TOLEDO TO COLUMBUS AND SOUTHWEST TO CINCINNATI. THUNDERSTORMS WITH HEAVY RAIN WERE FROM BELLEFONTAINE TO PLAIN CITY AND OVER XENIA IN CENTRAL OHIO.

THE THUNDERSTORMS WERE INCREASING IN COVERAGE AND INTENSITY AS THEY MOVED EAST AT ABOUT 45 MPH.
