

January-February, 1988 Significant Weather Advisories

January

Monday, January 25, 1988

A Snow Advisory is issued at 12:30PM for the late afternoon and evening. It is for 2"-3" of snow. Full text unavailable.

A daily snowfall record is established for the date. A total of 4.7" falls at Port Columbus, breaking the old record of 4.0" set in 1915.

Sunday, January 31, 1988

A daily record warm low temperature is established for the date. The low of 49 degrees at Port Columbus breaks the old record of 41 set in 1953.

February

Monday, February 1, 1988

A daily record warm low temperature is established for the date. The low of 51 degrees at Port Columbus breaks the old record of 43 degrees set in 1896.

A daily precipitation record was set for the date. 1.42" fell at Port Columbus, breaking the old record of 1.19" set in 1981.

Tuesday, February 2, 1988

A Freezing Rain Advisory is issued at 10AM for the afternoon. It is for rain changing to freezing rain or snow. Full text unavailable.

Wednesday, February 3, 1988

A Winter Storm Watch is issued at 3AM for the evening and overnight hours. The watch is for rain changing to snow with significant accumulations possible. Full text unavailable.

A Snow Advisory is issued at 3AM for the daytime hours for accumulations of 2"-3" by evening. Full text unavailable. The Winter Storm Watch issued the previous day continues for the overnight hours.

A Snow Advisory is continued for the morning hours, with snow accumulations of less than an inch. Full text unavailable.
