AT 522 PM EDT WEATHER SERVICE RADAR SHOWED VERY HEAVY THUNDERSTORMS OVER ROSS AND PICKAWAY COUNTIES. HAIL WAS INDICATED WITH THESE STORMS AND REPORTS OF HAIL WERE RECEIVED FROM NORTHERN ROSS COUNTY. THE THUNDERSTORMS ARE MOVING NORTH AT 25 MPH AND WILL REACH CIRCLEVILLE AROUND 545 PM EDT.

AT 555 PM EDT COLUMBUS WEATHER RADAR INDICATED THAT THE THUNDERSTORM IN THAT AREA HAD DIMINISHED AND NO LONGER POSES A THREAT TO THE COUNTY. RADAR CONTINUED TO SHOW SCATTERED SHOWERS AND HEAVY THUNDERSTORMS OVER THE SOUTHWEST ONE HALF OF OHIO AND WERE MOVING NORTH AT 35 MPH. THE ACTIVITY WILL BE MOVING THROUGH THE COLUMBUS AREA BY 700 PM EDT.
