THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN CLEVELAND
HAS ISSUED A HIGH WIND

ADVISORY FOR ALL OF OHIO EXCEPT THE FAR SOUTH AND SOUTHEAST TODAY.
THIS ADVISORY INCLUDES ALL EXCEPT FOR THE CITIES OF PORTSMOUTH...
CHILlicothe AND MARIETTA.

A HIGH WIND ADVISORY MEANS SUSTAINED WINDS OF 30 TO 39 MPH AND OR STRONG
GUSTY WINDS OF 45 TO 57 MILES AN HOUR ARE EXPECTED IN THE ADVISORY AREA.
A COLD FRONT JUST TO THE WEST OF OHIO EARLY THIS MORNING WILL MOVE
ACROSS THE STATE TODAY. GUSTY SOUTHWEST WINDS TO 30 MPH AHEAD OF THE
FRONT HAVE ALREADY BEEN REPORTED...AND THE WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO
INCREASE LATER TODAY AND SHIFT TO THE WEST AS THE FRONT MOVES THROUGH
THE STATE.

THE WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO DIMINISH OVER THE WESTERN COUNTIES LATE THIS
AFTERNOON AND CONTINUE TO DIMINISH INTO THE EVENING OVER THE EASTERN
SECTIONS. WINDS WILL TAPER OFF SIGNIFICANTLY OVERNIGHT...DIMINISHING AND
BECOMING NORTHWEST AT 10 TO 20 MPH IN THE NORTHEAST...AND LESS OVER THE
REST OF THE STATE.

DEEP LOW PRESSURE OVER THE CENTRAL PLAINS WILL MOVE RAPIDLY NORTHEAST TONIGHT. AS THE LOW PRESSURE MOVES TO WISCONSIN A COLD FRONT WILL BE APPROACHING OHIO'S WESTERN BORDERS. STRONG SOUTHWEST AND WEST WINDS ARE LIKELY AS THIS SYSTEM APPROACHES OHIO LATE TONIGHT AND MONDAY MORNING.

WIDESPREAD DENSE FOG WHICH FORMED OVER THE WESTERN THIRD OF OHIO OVERNIGHT WILL EXPAND OVER MUCH OF THE REST OF OHIO DURING THE PREDAWN HOURS. VISIBILITIES A QUARTER MILE OR LESS CAN BE EXPECTED...ESPECIALLY IN OUTLYING OR RURAL AREAS.
